Sensex, Nifty open higher amid positive global cues

Mumbai, Oct 29 (IANS) Indian stock markets opened on a strong note on Wednesday, supported by a positive trend in global markets.

The Sensex rose 191 points, or 0.23 per cent, to start the day at 84,820. Similarly, the Nifty climbed 74 points, or 0.29 per cent, to open at 26,011.

"After a positive opening, Nifty can find support at 25,900 followed by 25,850 and 25,800. On the higher side, 26,000 can be an immediate resistance, followed by 26,050 and 26,100," market experts said.

"The charts of Bank Nifty indicate that it may get support at 58,100 followed by 58,000 and 57,900. If the index advances further, 58,300 would be the initial key resistance, followed by 58,400 and 58,500," they added.

Among the top gainers on the Sensex were Asian

Paints, Sun Pharma, HCL Technologies, Trent, Tata Steel, Adani Ports, Titan, and Kotak Mahindra Bank.

On the other hand, Mahindra & Mahindra, Tata Motors, Bajaj Auto, Bajaj Finserv, and Bharat Electronics (BEL) were among the major losers.

In the broader market, the Nifty MidCap index inched up by 0.02 per cent, while the Nifty Small-Cap index slipped 0.28 per cent, showing a mixed trend among mid- and small-sized companies.

Sector-wise, the Nifty Metal index led the gains with a rise of 0.5 per cent, followed by the Financial Services, Private Bank, and FMCG indices, which were up about 0.2 per cent each.

Analysts said that market sentiment remained positive in early trade, with investors taking cues from the upbeat global market mood.

Groklopedia will exceed Wikipedia by several orders of magnitude in breadth, depth and accuracy: Elon Musk

New Delhi, Oct 29 (IANS) Elon Musk on Wednesday took a dig at Wikipedia, claiming that his new platform Groklopedia will surpass the popular online encyclopedia "by several orders of magnitude in breadth, depth and accuracy." Musk made the statement while responding to a user on his social media platform X. Developed by xAI, Musk's artificial intelligence company and the creator of the chatbot Grok, Groklopedia is an AI-powered encyclopedia that aims to challenge what Musk calls a "woke" and biased Wikipedia. He described Groklopedia as a "massive improvement over Wikipedia" and said it aligns with xAI's broader mission to help humanity better understand the universe.

RBI boosts gold holdings in India to 575.8 tonnes; domestic prices edge higher

Mumbai, Oct 29 (IANS) India's gold reserves are increasingly being stored within the country as the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) continues to shift its holdings back home.

The move comes at a time when nations across the world are using financial sanctions and asset freezes as tools of geopolitical pressure.

According to official data, the RBI brought around 64 tonnes of gold to India during the first six months of the current financial year.

As of September-end, India's total gold holdings stood at 880.8 tonnes, out of which 575.8 tonnes are now kept in domestic vaults. The remaining 290.3 tonnes are held with the Bank of England and the Bank for International Settlements (BIS).

Additionally, 14 tonnes are part of gold deposit arrangements, as per the official data. Since March 2023, the RBI has brought

back 274 tonnes of gold from overseas locations.

This large-scale repatriation began after the Russia-Ukraine conflict and the Taliban takeover of Afghanistan, when G7 nations froze the foreign currency reserves of both countries. The RBI's decision to keep a larger share of its gold at home reflects growing concerns over the safety of overseas reserves amid rising global tensions. Meanwhile, gold prices in India rose on Wednesday, tracking gains in international bullion markets ahead of the US Federal Reserve's interest rate decision. On the Multi Commodity Exchange (MCX), gold opened nearly flat at Rs



1,19,647 per 10 grams, compared to its previous close of Rs 1,19,646. Later, it rose by Rs 401 or 0.34 per cent, trading at Rs 1,20,047 per 10 grams during early trade.

Silver prices also gained, opening at Rs 1,44,761 per kg and rising Rs 989 or 0.69 per cent to Rs 1,45,331 per kg.

In the global market, spot gold edged up 0.2 per ounce, after touching its lowest level since October 7 on Tuesday.

However, easing US-China trade tensions limited gains, even as investors awaited an expected US Fed rate cut.

So far this year, gold prices have surged nearly 52 per cent, hitting an all-time high of \$4,381.21 per ounce on October 20.

The rally has been driven by global uncertainties, expectations of rate cuts, and continued buying by central banks, including the RBI.

Foreign currency deposits in S. Korea fall in Sept. on overseas investment: BOK

Seoul, Oct 29 (IANS) Foreign currency deposits in South Korea declined in September on increased overseas investments by pension funds and corporate payments for trade settlements, central bank data showed on Wednesday.

Outstanding foreign currency-denominated deposits held by residents came to \$107.09 billion as of end-September, down \$550 million from a month earlier, according to the data from the Bank of Korea (BOK), reports Yonhap news agency.

Residents include South Korean citizens, foreigners who have lived in the country for more than six months, and foreign companies. The data excludes interbank deposits.

Corporate foreign currency deposits fell \$700 million on-month to \$92.26

billion, while individual holdings edged up by \$150 million to \$14.83 billion.

By currency, U.S. dollar-denominated deposits dropped \$240 million to \$90.72 billion, and Japanese yen deposits declined \$150 million to \$8.89 billion. Euro deposits slipped \$120 million to \$5.01 billion.

But Chinese yuan deposits grew \$60 million to \$1.19 billion. "Dollar-denominated deposits declined mainly due to a decrease in investors' margin deposits at securities firms, overseas investments by pension funds



and corporate payments for trade settlements," a BOK official said.

Meanwhile, South Korean stocks extended gains late Wednesday morning, led mostly by chipmakers and other tech companies. The benchmark Korea Composite Stock Price Index had gained 56.77 points, or 1.42 per cent, to 4,067.18.

Top tech giant Samsung Electronics rose 1.11 per cent, and SK hynix added 4.22 per cent. Top search engine operator Naver jumped 5.73 per cent, and Kakao gained 8.01 per cent. Steelmakers traded higher as well, with POSCO Holdings rising 0.62 per cent and Korea Zinc climbing 8.28 per cent. The local currency was trading at 1,433.8 won against the greenback as of 11:20 a.m., up 3.9 won from the previous session's close.--IANS
